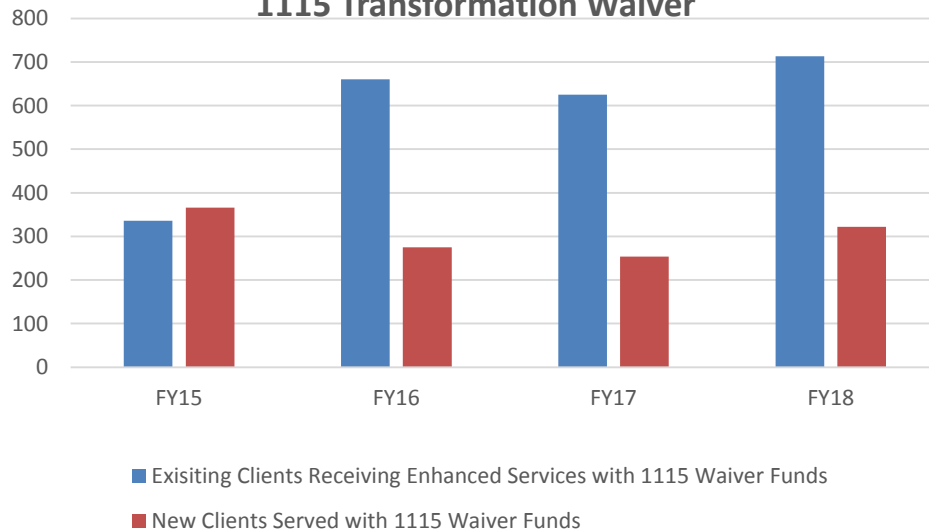

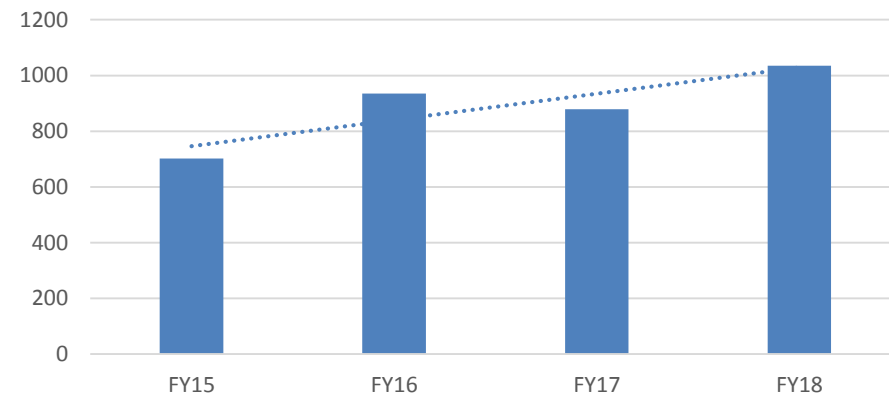

 4. M1-390 Time to initial Evaluation: Mean Days to Evaluation
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Successes and Challenges



Successes

- All performance year 1 achievement measures met
- Improved service delivery

Challenges

- Transition to a new medical record in the middle of performance year
 - Not having the ability to run reports to collect data
 - Selecting measures that require chart reviews.
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Lessons Learned



1. Work with your IT partners to ensure that everyone knows all data points that are needed for reporting
 2. Make cheat sheets from year to year to remember where data from previous years is located in the medical record
 3. Train, Train and Re-train staff on the measures.
